
From the CEO




2023 Highlights

Amistad's new Aransas Pass center was recognized as the leader in teen vaccination for San Patricio County


Quality Participation




In 2023 Pediatrics began serving youth at the Nueces Juvenile Detention Center



Amistad staff came together to support Christmas for 20 youth at the Boys and Girls Club.


